Proprietor Pam Cross presented a structured tasting of the fine wines of the Southern Barossa. Pam explained that to enhance the range, fruit is also sourced from the Adelaide Hills and Eden Valley. To demonstrate the wisdom Pam showed some superb Eden Valley Riesling and Adelaide Hills Sauvignon Blanc. These medal winning whites were followed by "The Old Barossa Blend", the Southern Barossa Shiraz and the flagship Saint Urban Barossa Shiraz, all medal winners in their own right.

Fortifieds followed with a unique Fortified Riesling named "The Jazzie" after Pam's

granddaughter. "The Sommelier" a superb Tawny blended with material averaging 25 years was served with dessert followed by a youthful 06 vintage Shiraz.

Two door prizes were drawn and it proved to be Simon Granfield's night, taking home a triple gift pack of Winter Creek Wines while Tony Impett grabbed bottle of "The Old Barossa blend"
